OIL PAINTING

WED AM'S: 10:00 - 13H00 (3 HR SESSIONS)

21st Feb, 28th Feb, 6th March, 13th March (BREAK), 3rd April, 10th April & 17th April

This course caters for those artists who enjoy oil painting and are happy to push their own boundaries with the help of carefully selected subjects, themes, approaches and techniques. My aim is to focus our attention on good colour mixing and to explore at least one painting style. The term will be divided into 3 modules to allow for variation and flexibility.

£40 Watercolour Glazes

Saturday 17th February

10:00 - 13H00 (3 HOUR SESSION)

Glazing is a similar watercolour technique to a wash, but uses a thin, transparent pigment applied over dry existing washes. Its purpose is to adjust the colour and tone of the underlying wash. The quality of colour is enhanced by largely colour mixing on the paper. The result is fresh, clear and pure ... our very own stained glass window. It will certainly make us aware of how much we tend to overwork our paintings! An invaluable exercise for novice and experienced water colourists.

I will choose a juicy and rewarding subject to absorb us for the day. Bic or Gelly roll pens capture the detail and texture whilst the selected areas of acrylic paint, or ink, bring the subject to life.

£65 Watercolours: Loose & Lively

Friday 22nd March

10:00 - 15H00 (5 HOUR SESSION)

Why use 10 brushstrokes, when you only need one? The consideration given to each brush mark is a discipline worth mastering, as it can help you become more assertive and less fussy. To be loose, is to suggest and not to copy. The ability to reduce a complex subject into a series of simple shapes is the key to achieving your goal.

We will warm up with a little exercise before enjoying a more involved subject. A relaxed pastel pencil illustrative line will aid us in our quest. All details to be outlined in your lesson plan.

£105 OIL: WIPE-OUT (WITH A TWIST)

FRIDAY 5TH APRIL SATURDAY 6TH APRIL

10:00 - 13H00 (3 HOUR SESSION) 10:00 - 15H00 (5 HOUR SESSION)

A wonderful, tactile method of creating either an underpainting or a completed artwork. I thoroughly enjoy this approach, both in drawing and painting, as it teaches the artist a great deal about tonal shaping in particular. It is a reliable way to achieve a likeness. There is also an element of mystery as the image slowly emerges from the canvas. Well placed brushstrokes will complete your portrait. I am introducing another element into the process for a change. All will be revealed in the lesson plan.

You will find that by limiting your colour choices, you can concentrate entirely on what tone goes where and how transparent or opaque the layers need to be, depending on what you are trying to describe. You will be able to practice your wash techniques without colour mixing getting in the way. A wonderful opportunity to hone your watercolour skills. Suitable for all levels.

£65 Mixed Media: A Portrait

This portrait has the potential to be extremely colourful, quirky, lively, stylised, joyful and entertaining. If it brings a smile to your face, then job done! You can certainly push your boundaries.

- CREATIVE * Line Drawing of your portrait on your canvas / support.

- Laying down acrylic washes and using wipe out to create basic form,
- * Collage ("Painting with paper shapes"). These patterns and colours will allow you to express your subject's personality.
- Clear gesso protects the collage before final layers of paint are applied

PASTEL & WASH: WILD LIFE PORTRAITS £130
